

Admission Criteria

All applicants for the Diploma Program in Advanced Orthopaedic Manual Therapy (Dip. AOMPT) will meet the following criteria:

- 1. Applicants must provide proof of Philippine Licensure (PRC License).
 - a. foreign applicants can apply but must be licensed to practice in the location of training/mentorship.
- 2. Applicants must meet all eligibility requirements to practice in clinical affiliate sites.
- 3. Applicants must meet the following prerequisites: OMPT-Certified Clinician
- 4. Applicants must complete all required sections of the application form.
- Applicants must submit a current CV to <u>omptsg@gmail.com</u> outlining all academic achievements, certification, and continuing education courses. The CV should account for experience in the last 5 years.

Admission Process:

- Admission to the Diploma program is competitive and requires a significant monetary and professional commitment.
- Admission to the OMPTSG Diploma in Advanced Orthopaedic Manual Therapy program is a fully transparent and standardized process. Selection of trainees will be conducted without regard to sex, religion, or sexual orientation. The decision for acceptance will be made based on the strength of each individual application. Max of ten (10) trainees will be accepted in each cohort.
- Applicants will complete the application form and include a current CV to email: <u>omptsg@gmail.com</u>
- Program admission begins every January of each year. Exceptions may be made for extenuating circumstances and must be requested in writing. A final decision on eligible applications will be made by the program director. Applicants are encouraged to submit their application early, as the admission process is competitive.
- All applications will be reviewed by the Program Director within 2-weeks of receipt. Applicants will be ranked on a 100-point scale based on the strength of each component of the application. Point values are assigned as follows:
 - a. PT License and eligibility requirements: 10 pts
 - b. Essay Questions: 30 pts
 - c. Letter of Recommendations: 30 pts
 - d. Curriculum vitae 30 pts
- Competitive applicants will be interviewed via Zoom Teleconference by the Director and a member of the management team within three weeks from application receipt.
- Applicants will be notified by email on acceptance to the program within 30 days of receipt of the application.
- Selected PTs in Training must return the accompanying letter of agreement by email to the program Director within 30 days of receipt of acceptance notification.
- Selected PTs in Training must sign and submit the "PT in Training Agreement Form" and the "Clinical Site Agreement Form" enclosed.
